



# The EU-Mercosur agreement: Expectations and concerns in light of the new geopolitical situation

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### Introduction

- The EU-Mercosur agreement has been widely debated among political figures in Brazil, Argentina, and Paraguay since mid-2022. The EU's attempt to recalibrate its global affiliations during ongoing supply-chain disruptions and the geopolitical impact of the Russian war against Ukraine has further intensified the debate.
- Significant progress has been made in the EU-Mercosur deal since 2019. While it
  presents potential advantages, it also raises certain concerns. The involvement of
  the US and China and the impact of agriculture and raw materials industries are
  central to the ongoing discussions about the agreement.


## **The EU-Mercosur Association Agreement**

- Scope: The agreement aims to establish a free trade area covering goods, services, non-tariff measures, intellectual property rights, and sustainable development.
- Tariffs: The agreement aims to eliminate or reduce tariffs on a significant portion
  of trade between the EU and the Mercosur countries.
- Agricultural Products: One of the most contentious aspects of the agreement is the liberalization of agricultural trade.
- **Sustainable Development:** Commitments to uphold environmental and labour standards, fostering sustainable growth practices (European Commission, 2023).





## **Evolution of Trade Flows: EU-Mercosur (2002-2022)**



## **Total EU exports to Mercosur countries (2002-2022)**





## Raw Materials: EU-Mercosur (2002-2022)



## Agricultural Trade: EU-Mercosur (2002-2022)



## Manufacture exports: Austria to Mercosur (2021)



## **Agriculture exports: Austria to Mercosur (2021)**



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# **Exports shares from EU, China and USA to Mercosur countries (2021)**



## **General Equilibrium Effects EU-Mercosur: changes in Real GDP (%)**



## **Conclusions**

- Increased political drive in both the EU and Mercosur bloc to ratify the EU-Mercosur Association Agreement, influenced by global geopolitical disruptions.
- Empirical evidence suggests substantial economic gains from the agreement, more so for Mercosur than the EU.
- The EU aims to diversify raw material sources, with Brazil being key.
- Statements from both sides indicate a possible ratification by year's end, promising clarity on the agreement's future soon.
- Negotiations include the EU Deforestation Regulation to ensure commodities are deforestation-free, addressing environmental concerns.
